End of Year Excursion to the Bathurst Aquatic Centre



The End of Year Excursion has been booked for TOMORROW, Tuesday 12th December at the Bathurst Aquatic Centre. The cost is \$8.50 per child. We will depart from Trunkey Public School at 9am.

There will be an organised and supervised Inflatable Island for students who can swim 25m unassisted.

There will be organised and supervised water sports/games available for students who cannot swim 25m unassisted.

Students will only be permitted to participate in one or the other organised activity, not both, and the choice of activity will be determined by the child's swimming ability. These activities will be run by Belgravia Leisure's swimming instructors. The school and P&C Association have covered the cost for these activities.

The students will enjoy Kris Kringle gift giving after lunch on the Party Day. Please organise a Kris Kringle gift for the day for any additional children as we don't want anyone to feel left out.

Dress Rehearsal

A group photo will be taken of the cast for inclusion in the Presentation Night Programme before rehearsals commence. The dress rehearsal is our opportunity to ensure that the students' movements on stage will not be hampered by their costumes and helps us anticipate any difficulties that may occur on the night in time to make any necessary changes to ensure a problem-free performance the following evening.

If your child has been cast as more than one character, please ensure all items of costume are delivered to the hall. All students will require their school bag and a packed morning tea and lunch. There will be no lunch orders available on Thursday as we plan to be at the hall for most of the day.

Please place your child's school uniform in a plastic bag labelled with your child's name and tied to their school bag. That way, the staff can ensure that, after your child gets changed, all costumes can be returned to the correct student.

Presentation Night

Our school's annual Presentation Night will be held on Friday 15th December following the school play performance. 'FROZEN.'

Please ensure all students arrive at the Trunkey Hall by 6:15pm dressed in full costume. Any additional costume items will have been left at the hall from Thursday's Dress Rehearsal. The play is estimated to run for a little over 1 hour, with supper to be held at


